A Billion Eyes Searching

From London to India, God is working mightily in the lives of South Asians. While we rejoice in the ways God has moved in the hearts and lives of South Asians, we must acknowledge the heart-wrenching reality that there are more than a billion people still considered lost. A billion eyes are searching to find truth. A billion eyes are searching to fill a void deep within the depths of their hearts. Over 1.5 billion South Asians represent nations, tribes and peoples who do not know Jesus. Will you fast and pray for them? Will you reach out to them in love? Will you tell them about Jesus?

- Pray that the Gospel will spread rapidly among the Devanga of southern India and that these weavers of garments will be clothed in the righteousness of Christ.
- As the Bhar of Uttar Pradesh struggle under the oppression of physical poverty, ask the Father to release them from spiritual oppression, shining the light of His truth upon them and vanquishing the demons that keep the Bhar chained in darkness.
- Pray that the Khangar, a farming people in Madhya Pradesh, will look to the true God who gives rain to the earth and provides the harvest.
- Pray that the river-dwelling Jalia Kaibarta of northeast India will embrace the Lord and drink of the living water Jesus gives, that they may never thirst again.
- Pray for the Mal people who, as Buddhists, hate violence yet do not know Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace.
- Pray that the Navithar women, known for their outer adornments and tattoos, will be transformed by grace and know the inner beauty of love, kindness and compassion.
- More than 500,000 South Asians have moved to London. One of the larger groups to make this move is the Sylhetti of Bangladesh. Pray for opportunities to share the Gospel with Sylhetti families moving to London and other parts of the United Kingdom.

- Pray that the Prince of Peace will reveal Himself to the Kolai of northwest Pakistan and that His message of hope will dispel the fear or war.

Punjabi is the largest South Asian language group in Canada. Pray for the truth of our magnificent Savior to take root in the hearts of South Asians in Canada and around the world.
